

NOTICE TO THE BAR

Probation - Rescinded Directives

In the Judiciary's efforts to maintain current and relevant policies and procedures, all of the Administrative Directives affecting the Probation Division have been reviewed. As a result of that review, the Probation-related Directives have been categorized as follows: (a) Directives Requiring No Revision and remaining in effect as issued; (b) Rescinded Directives; (c) Directives with Technical Revisions; (d) Directives Containing Substantive Changes; and (e) Directives Pending Revisions (these directives will require further updates, to be developed and issued at a later time).


This Notice lists the Directive in the second category referenced above, that is, the one Probation-related Directive that has been rescinded as part of this review process. The text of this rescinded directive will be removed from the compilation of directives, retaining only the number, date, and subject for historical reference purposes. The Directive that is rescinded by this Notice is as follows (including the basis for rescission):

Probation

#39-61 – Probation Officers- Designation of Work Hours

This Directive dealt with Probation Officer work hours. The Probation Officer title is covered in the Judiciary collective negotiations agreements and the Judiciary Overtime Policy. The Directive is outdated and no longer necessary.
