

**NOTICE TO THE BAR**  
**2002 *PRO HAC VICE* ASSESSMENT**

R. 1:21-2 requires those admitted *pro hac vice* to pay the annual assessment.

The Supreme Court of New Jersey having ruled on the Disciplinary Oversight Committee (“DOC”) and New Jersey Lawyers Assistance Program (“NJLAP”) budgets for 2002, the New Jersey Lawyers’ Fund for Client Protection (“Fund”) is now in a position to collect the assessment for *pro hac vice* admission for calendar year 2002. As always, the money collected through the assessment will support not only the Fund, but the disciplinary process as well. Funding will also be provided for the NJLAP. The breakdown for 2002 is as follows:
