RE: REVISIONS TO CIVIL CASE INFORMATION STATEMENT - CASE TYPE

LISTING ON REVERSE SIDE

The Supreme Court has approved revisions to the listing of case types on the reverse side of the Civil Case Information Statement (Appendix XII-B to the Rules of Court). The revisions include adding a new case type under Track I for summary actions brought under the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) and three mass tort case types under Track IV (Propulsid, Ciba-Geigy, and PPA), as well as the removal of the breast implant case type from the mass tort list. These revisions are effective October 1, 2002.

Please note that, although the revised CIS is effective as of October 1, 2002, Civil Division staff in the vicinages have been instructed to accept the version appearing in the 2003 Gann and West editions of the *Rules of Court* through this calendar year. Attorneys filing OPRA actions using this earlier version of the CIS are reminded to write in the 802 case type code.
