Re: Proposed Amendments to Rules Governing the IOLTA Program

The Trustees of the IOLTA Board of the Bar of New Jersey have filed a proposal to amend certain portions of Rules 1:21-6(a) and 1:28A. If adopted, the amendments would result in approved financial institution remitting a "reasonable and comparable" portion of income earned on non-interest bearing accounts maintained by attorneys.

The Supreme Court has directed that the proposal of the IOLTA Trustees be published for comment. Contemporaneous with this Notice, you will find the [proposed amendments](#) and an [Explanatory Statement](#) that has been prepared by the Trustees.
