SUPREME COURT RULES COMMITTEE REPORTS - PUBLICATION FOR COMMENT

The Supreme Court invites written comments on the 2004-07 reports of the Supreme Court rules and program committees published with this notice. In those reports, the committees (as listed below) make numerous recommendations to the Supreme Court for rule amendments and other non-rule administrative actions.
