

NOTICE TO THE BAR

FREE ACCESS TO ACMS FOR JEFIS ATTORNEYS

Effective immediately, attorneys who are registered users of JEFIS have access to ACMS for information on DC docket-type cases free of charge. “JEFIS” is the Judiciary Electronic Filing/Imaging System, which is used by attorneys to electronically file documents in Special Civil Part cases involving \$15,000 or less (i.e., DC docket-type cases). “ACMS” is the Automated Case Management System, which serves as the civil docket in New Jersey. Once a user has logged onto JEFIS, ACMS public access to DC cases is available via a URL link. This will enable participating attorneys to ascertain the status of their cases without having to make a telephone call or write a letter to the clerk’s office.
