NOTICE TO THE BAR

EVIDENCE RULE AMENDMENT TAKES EFFECT – FORFEITURE BY WRONGDOING EXCEPTION TO THE HEARSAY RULE (<u>N.J.R.E.</u> 804(b)(9))

In a September 15, 2010 Notice to the Bar, the Supreme Court announced that, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 2A:84A-35, it had amended the New Jersey Rules of Evidence by adopting a new subparagraph (b)(9) to the hearsay rule (N.J.R.E. 804) so as to provide a forfeiture-by-wrongdoing exception to the hearsay rule. There having been no legislative action in respect of this amendment to the Rules of Evidence as provided for by N.J.S.A. 2A:84A-36, N.J.R.E. 804(b)(9) became effective on July 1, 2011.
