MASS TORTS – APPLICATION FOR MASS TORT DESIGNATION OF NEW JERSEY STATE-COURT LITIGATION INVOLVING THE DRUG PROPECIA

Pursuant to Directive #7-09, “Revised Mass Tort Guidelines,” an application has been made to the Supreme Court, through the Acting Administrative Director of the Courts, requesting designation of all New Jersey state-court litigation involving the drug Propecia as a mass tort. The application includes a request that the litigation, if designated as a mass tort, be assigned to Atlantic County for centralized management.
