

NOTICE TO THE BAR

NEW JERSEY SUPREME COURT OFFERS ATTORNEYS A CONVENIENT ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION SYSTEM AND DISCOUNTED ANNUAL ASSESSMENT FOR 2012

Pursuant to Rules 1:20-1(b) and (c), 1:28-2(a), 1:28B-1(e), and 1:42-2(b), attorneys licensed to practice in New Jersey are annually required to pay an assessment and file a registration statement in a form prescribed by the Administrative Director with approval of the Supreme Court. The New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection ("Fund") collects the assessment; the money collected supports the Fund, the disciplinary process, the Lawyers Assistance Program and the Board on Continuing Legal Education.

The 2012 registration and payment are now due. The Supreme Court is encouraging lawyers to register and pay electronically by offering a \$5 discount of the 2012 fee to those who register and pay online. A \$40 late fee will be assessed after April 27 but the \$5 discount will still apply.

A User ID and temporary password has been mailed to the address on file for each attorney who has never used the online system. An electronic notice about the on-line system and \$5 discount has been sent to each attorney who has previously registered on-line. To complete your registration and pay online, go to www.njcourts.com/attyreg, click on "Attorney Online Registration and Payment Center" and follow the on-screen directions.
