Re: IOLTA Ineligible List

The arrival of Hurricane Sandy coincided with the publication of the 2012 IOLTA Ineligible List. Some attorneys may have missed seeing the Order and List because of disruptions caused by the storm.

The Supreme Court has entered an Order declaring attorneys who did not comply with the mandatory IOLTA program in 2012 to be administratively ineligible to practice law. The Court's Order took effect on October 22, 2012 and the list of ineligible attorneys was published on the Judiciary's website on the same day and in the New Jersey Law Journal on October 29, 2012.

Attorneys on the IOLTA ineligibility list will remain there until in full compliance with the requirements of <u>Rule</u> 1:28A-2 and the IOLTA Trustees so report to the Court.
