REMINDER – COMPUTATION OF DISCOVERY END DATE IN CASES REMANDED FROM FEDERAL COURT – AMENDMENTS TO RULE 4:24-1 – JANUARY 1 OPERATIONAL DATE

This notice is a reminder that, as set forth in the notice dated August 7, 2014, the amendment to Rule 4:24-1 (“Time for Completion of Discovery”) that the Supreme Court adopted as part of its July 22, 2014 omnibus rule amendment order, while having a formal effective date of September 1, 2014, had a January 1, 2015 operational date. That delayed operational date was to allow for the necessary programming changes to be made to the Judiciary’s Automated Case Management System.
