SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

Pursuant to N.J. Const. Art VI, sec. 2 par. 3, it is ORDERED that, effective retroactive to July 1, 2016, the provisions of Rule 4:59-1(e) of the Rules Governing the Courts of the State of New Jersey are relaxed and supplemented so as authorize the Clerk of the Special Civil Part, consistent with the Judiciary's Standards for Electronic Records Management, to affix the designated judge's electronic signature on wage execution orders for uncontested wage applications upon certifying that the requirements of that Rule and all applicable Part VI Rules have been met.

The provisions of this Order shall remain in effect pending adoption of conforming amendments to the Rules of Court.
