Judiciary Computer Application Testing for Criminal Justice Reform

Beginning December 1, 2016, the New Jersey Judiciary for portions of the month of December will be conducting a statewide test of the computer applications being developed for Criminal Justice Reform. Test runs of the Public Safety Assessment (PSA) and test court orders will be generated in individual cases and will be viewable in the eCourts electronic case file by the attorneys of record in those cases (prosecutors, public defenders, and private defense bar). These test documents will be clearly marked as being for system testing purposes only. Attorneys of record may also receive test email notifications, which when stored as a pdf in the case jacket will be clearly marked as being for system testing purposes.
