STATUS OF CIVIL PRACTICE COMMITTEE'S PROPOSED RULE ON MOTION IN LIMINE PRACTICE

In its 2016-2018 Report, the Supreme Court Civil Practice Committee recommended adoption of a new Rule 4:25-8 to address motion *in limine* practice. This proposed new rule as submitted by the Practice Committee was intended to regularize the practice, define the obligations of the bar, and promote earlier preparation, discussion of issues and settlement of cases. The Court determined not to act on the proposed rule during this rules cycle, but rather referred it back to the Civil Practice Committee for further study. Once the Practice Committee has completed that additional process, it will submit a revised proposal to the Court.
