CIVIL CASE INFORMATION STATEMENT (CIVIL CIS) – **REVISIONS TO PAGE 2 -- ADDITION AND REMOVAL OF VARIOUS CASE TYPES**

The Civil Case Information statement (“Civil CIS”) is included in the Rules of Court as Appendix XII-B1. The Supreme Court has previously delegated to the Administrative Director the authority to approve revisions to Page 2 of the Civil CIS. Accordingly, this notice promulgates the following revision to Page 2 of the Civil CIS, effective immediately:

- The addition of case type 625 for litigation alleging firefighter hearing loss from excessive noise exposure from certain Federal Signal Corporation sirens;
- The addition of case type 626 for litigation alleging injuries resulting from use of the drug Abilify;
- The addition of case type 627 for litigation alleging injuries resulting from use of Physiomesh Flexible Composite Mesh;
- The addition of case type 628 for litigation alleging injuries resulting from the use of Taxotere (docetaxel);
- The addition of case type 629 for litigation alleging injuries resulting from use of the Zostavax vaccine; and
- The removal of case type 290 as the multicounty designation of the Pompton Lakes Environmental Contamination Litigation has been terminated.

The complete Civil CIS as revised effective October 10, 2018 is attached.
