

NOTICE TO THE BAR

USE OF THE UNIFORM SUMMARY SUPPORT ORDER (USSO) FOR ALL CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS

This is a reminder that the Uniform Summary Support Order (USSO) (Form #CN 10284) must be used to establish or modify a child support obligation in all Family Part matters. This requirement includes child support obligations that are paid directly between the parties.

Historically, in the dissolution docket (FM docket), any child support obligation was included as part of the final judgment or property settlement agreement. This notice is to clarify that the USSO must be submitted in addition to the final judgment and the property settlement agreement. Furthermore, this requirement applies when establishing the child support obligation both in cases enforced by the Probation Division as well as in cases where the child support obligation will be paid directly between the parties. The FM docket includes the following matters: divorce/dissolution of a marriage, dissolution of a civil union, and the termination of a domestic partnership.
