Passaic County to Conduct Virtual Court
Election Day Hearings on May 12, 2020

On May 12, 2020 the citizens of Passaic County will be able to participate in vote-by-mail elections. Voting ballots have been mailed by the Passaic County Clerk's Office to all registered voters. To ensure access to justice even though the courthouse doors are closed, a Superior Court judge will be available to conduct remote hearings for any election challenges or issues.

If appropriate, those offices will make arrangements for the voter to appear with appropriate social distancing measures in place in a designated courtroom in the Passaic County Administration Building, 401 Grand Street, Paterson. All other participants in those hearings, including the judge and attorneys, will be appearing remotely by video.

Towns holding elections are the Borough of Totowa and the City of Passaic for School Board Elections and the City of Paterson for municipal elections.
