## ONLINE ATTORNEY REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT FOR 2021 – POST-DEADLINE REMINDER – JUNE 1 DATE TO AVOID INELIGIBLE STATUS

The deadline for attorneys to complete their annual registration and payment for 2021 was March 5, 2021. Those attorneys who have not yet completed that process may still do so, with the additional payment of late fees, until June 1, 2021. Those attorneys who do not complete the process by that June 1, 2021 final date may be declared by Supreme Court order to be ineligible to practice law. by Order of the Supreme Court of New Jersey upon publication of the 2021 Ineligible List. This notice serves as a reminder of the June 1, 2021 deadline. Additional notice will be provided to attorneys through notice to the bar, automated calls and by email as reminders of the approaching June 1, 2021 deadline to avoid being declared ineligible to practice law in New Jersey.
