Hudson Vicinage to Conduct Virtual Court Election Day Hearings

Superior Court judges will be available in Hudson County to conduct remote hearings for any election issues concerning the general election during the early voting period and on election day on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

In this general election, voters may either vote-by-mail or in person at their designated polling places on election day. Additionally, early voters may choose to cast ballots before election day beginning on Saturday, October 23, 2021, through Sunday, October 31, 2021. Early voters may vote from 10 a.m. through 8 p.m. during the week and on the designated Saturdays. Polls will close at 6 p.m. on October 24 and on October 31, 2021.

Designated judges are available to promptly hear any election matters beginning on October 23, 2021. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear either by video or by telephone.
