NOTICE TO THE BAR

TRANSCRIPT FEES - INCREASES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025

This notice is to advise that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:7-4, per page fees for the production of transcripts have increased effective July 1, 2025.

Transcript fees are recalculated every five years on July 1 using a specific formula set forth in N.J.S.A. 2B:7-4(b) to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The courts do not set transcript fees.

As of July 1, 2025, the fee for original standard delivery transcripts has increased from \$4.68 to \$5.73 for each page of an original and from \$0.78 to \$0.95 per page for copies. Expedited and daily transcript rates also have increased. The new fees are as follows:

| Type of Service | Transcript Returned | Fee for Original Transcript | Fee for Additional Copy of Transcript |
|--------------------|------------------------------|--------------------------------|--|
| Standard | within 30 business days | \$5.73 per page | \$0.95 per page |
| Expedited | within 7 to 10 business days | \$8.60 per page | \$1.43 per page |
| Daily | next business day | \$11.46 per page | \$1.90 per page |

The fee increases apply to any "transcript of a stenographic record or other recording in any court or in any other proceeding recorded at the direction of the Supreme Court."
