


ORDER

THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court on June 25, 2025, and said hearing having been conducted on application of Defendant Paul Caneiro (Monika Mastellone, appearing) for an order to suppress Defendant's unrecorded statements, opposed by Raymond Santiago, Monmouth County Prosecutor (Christopher Decker and Nicole Wallace, Assistant Prosecutors, appearing) for the State of New Jersey; and the Court having heard argument and having incorporated all submitted briefs into the record in accordance with Rule 2:6-1(a)(2), and for the reasons stated on the record, and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 25TH day of JUNE, 2025;

ORDERED that Defendant's motion to suppress his unrecorded statements is DENIED in part and GRANTED in part. Defendant's request to preclude the unrecorded statements is denied, and the statements in question may be testified to by the officers who received them. It is further

ORDERED that Defendant's request in the alternative for a Hampton/Kociolek jury instruction is granted. Parties shall include proposed jury instruction to this effect in their pretrial memos.
