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Hudson Vicinage to Hold Landlord Tenant Webinar

The Hudson Vicinage will host a virtual landlord tenant seminar to explain court processes and procedures on Thursday, Oct. 28 from 5 to 6:30 p.m.

Topics to be addressed include:

- The role of courts in resolving landlord tenant matters, focusing on eviction complaints.
- The court's commitment to reducing the risks of housing instability resulting from evictions due to non-payment of rent.
- The status of court processes relating to non-payment of rent.
- The rights and responsibilities of landlords and tenants.
- The self-certification process and other resources to assist landlords and tenants.
- The services of the Judiciary's ombudsman program.

Vicinage judges and staff will discuss landlord tenant court processes. Dean Dafis of the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs and a representative from Northeast New Jersey Legal Services will discuss a variety of available services, with a focus on resources for landlords and tenants.
