Justice Fabiana Pierre-Louis to Administer Oath of Citizenship at Passaic Vicinage Naturalization Ceremony

New Jersey Supreme Court Associate Justice Fabiana Pierre-Louis will administer the Oath of Citizenship to 37 new citizens during a naturalization ceremony on Wednesday, July 26.

The ceremony will take place at 9 a.m. on the steps of the Passaic County Courthouse, 71 Hamilton St., Paterson. In case of inclement weather, the ceremony will take place in the ceremonial courtroom, room 222 on the second floor of the courthouse.

Passaic County Elections Superintendent Shona Mack-Pollock will discuss voters rights and responsibilities, Passaic County Clerk Danielle Ireland-Imhof will speak to the new citizens about U.S. passports, and Jury Manager Maria Vlahos will speak about jury service. The new citizens also will witness a demonstration of the use of a voting machine.
