Excludable Time Order

This matter having been opened to the Court on joint application of Raymond S Santiago, Monmouth County Prosecutor, (Christoph J Decker, Assistant Prosecutor, appearing), and defendant Paul J Caneiro (Monika T Mastellone, appearing) for an order granting a continuance of the proceedings in the above-captioned matter from 05/09/2025 through 06/03/2025, and defendant having the right to have the trial in this matter commence within 180 days following the return or unsealing of the indictment or the detention of the defendant pursuant to Rule 3:26-2(d)(1), whichever is later and the defendant and Raymond S Santiago, Monmouth County Prosecutor, (Christoph J Decker, Assistant Prosecutor, appearing), having agreed and for good cause shown,

THE COURT FINDS that this application should be granted for the following reasons:

To allow time for disposition of a motion for The Defendant has filed several motions as of May 7, 2025, including: a motion to preclude arson expert testimony, motion to preclude ballistics evidence, motion to suppress evidence seized with a warrant, motion to suppress DVR evidence seized and searched without a warrant, and motion to preclude financial crimes/motive evidence. The first of these motions is returnable June 3, 2025. Furthermore, the Defendant's petition for certiorari regarding this court's March 6, 2025, order to admit DNA evidence is currently pending before the New Jersey Supreme Court.

WHEREFORE, IT IS on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 2025

ORDERED that 26 day(s), from 05/09/2025 through 06/03/2025, is excludable time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:162-22b.(1)(c) and is attributed to defendant pursuant to R. 3:25-4(d)(2)(C).
