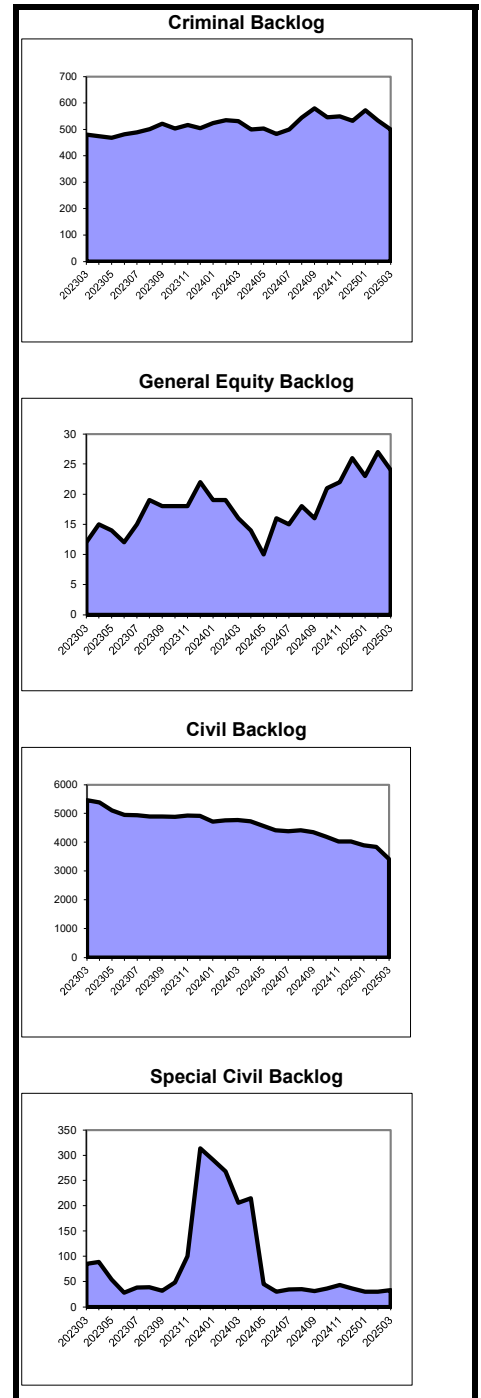

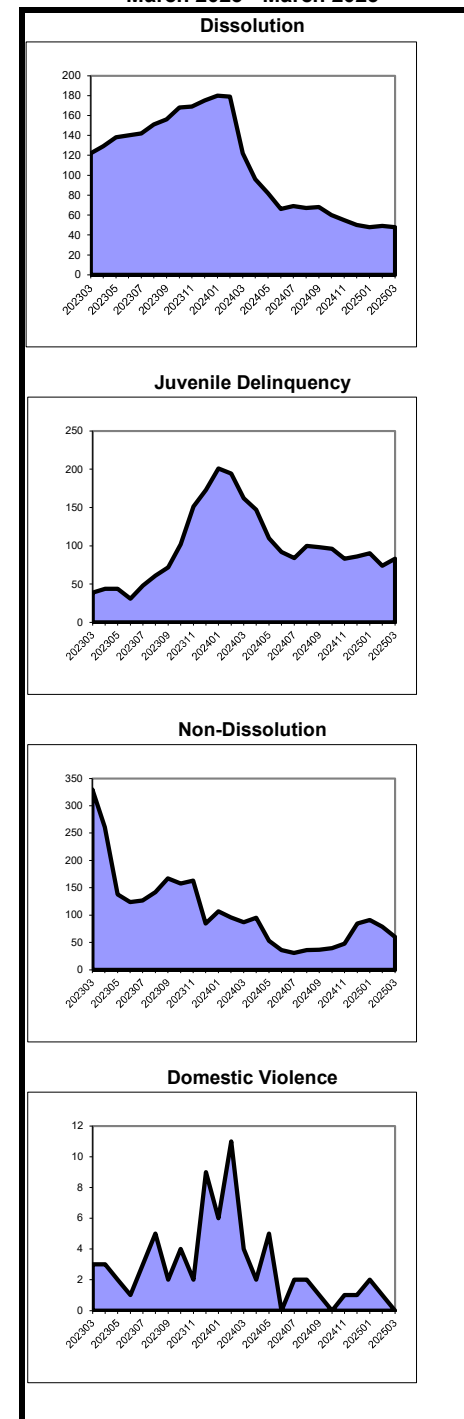

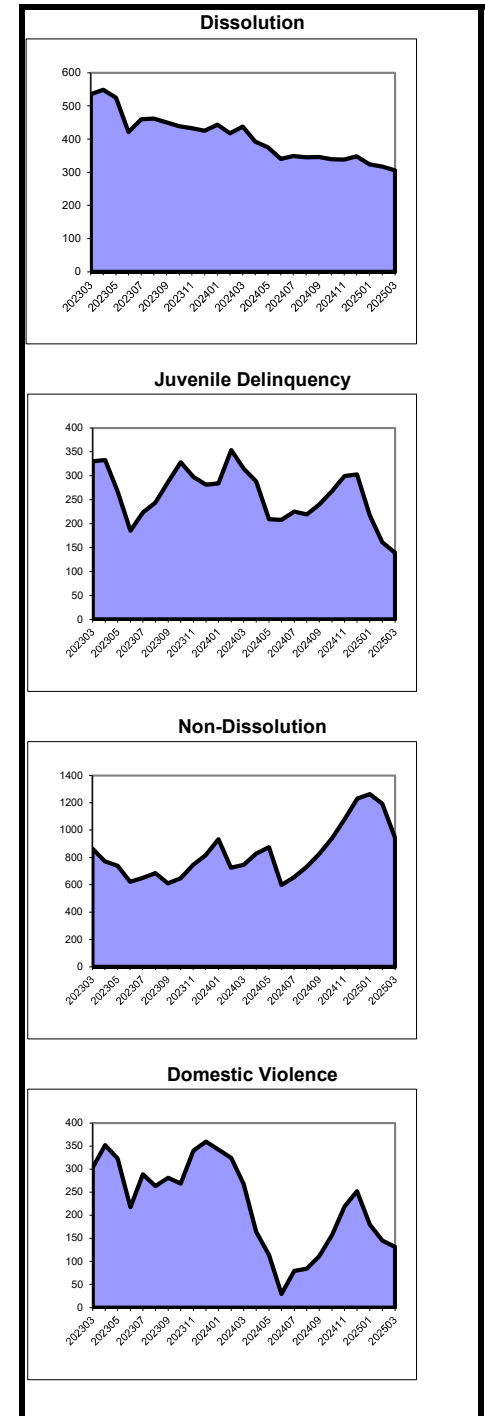

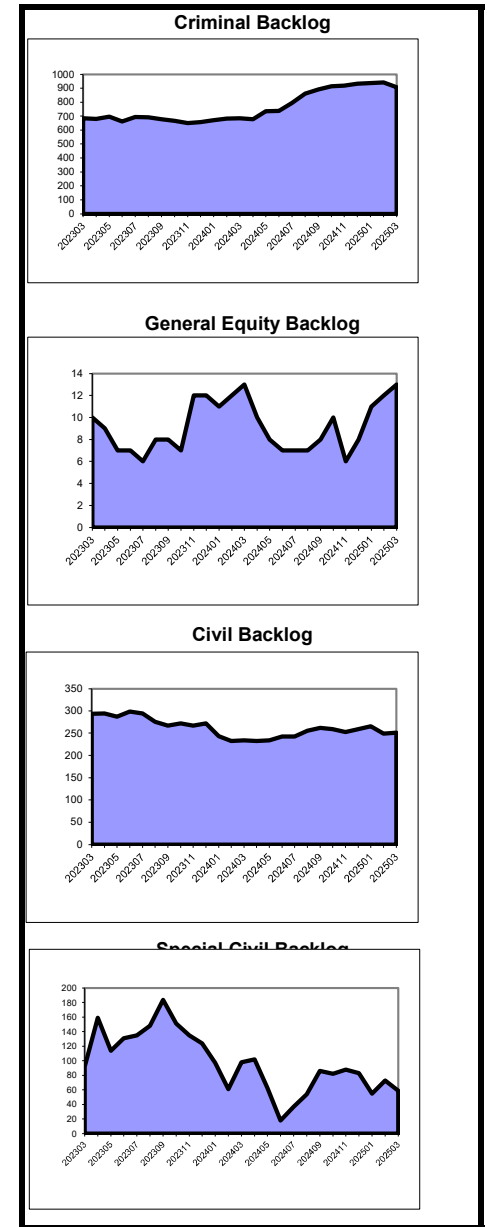

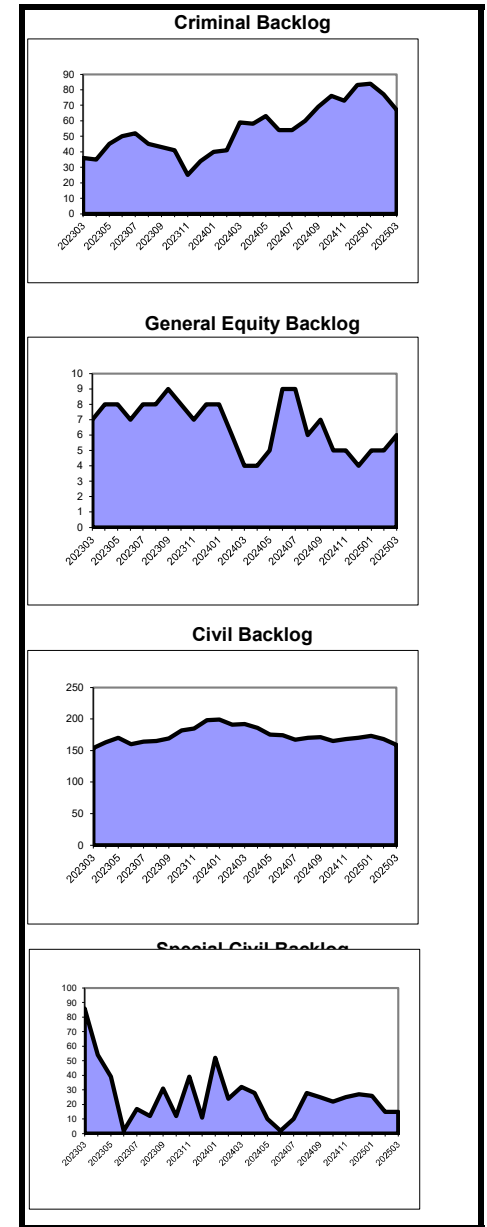

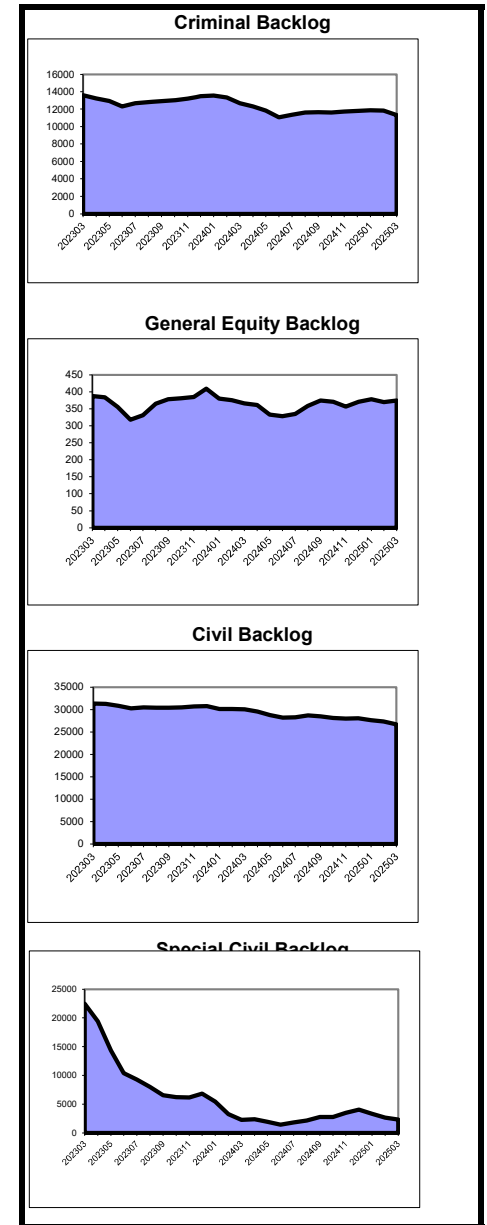

March 2023 - March 2025

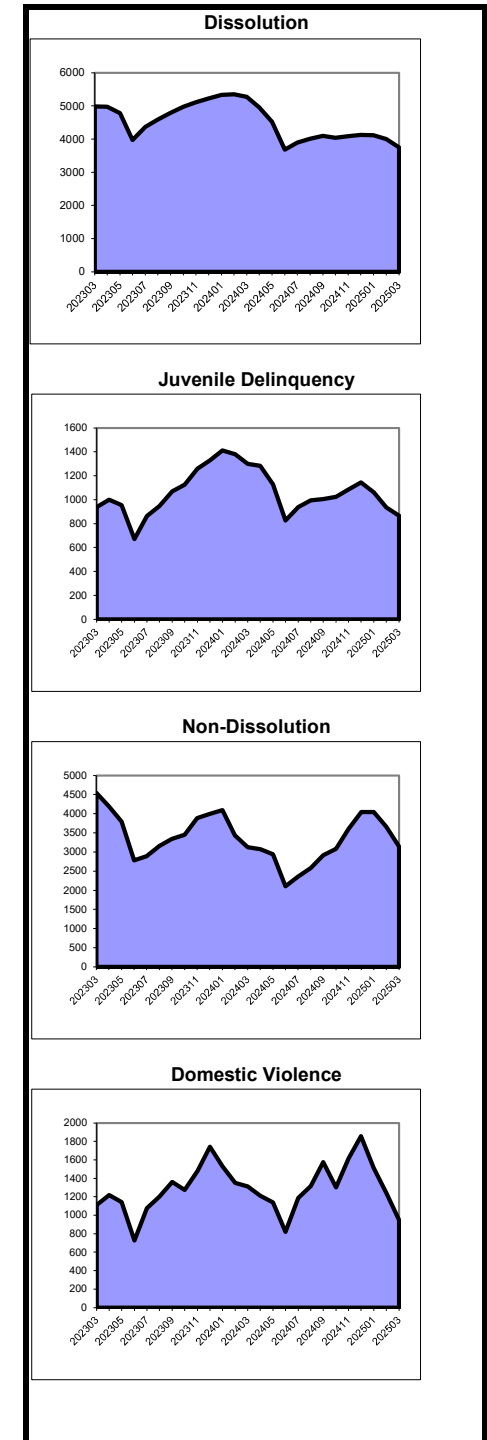

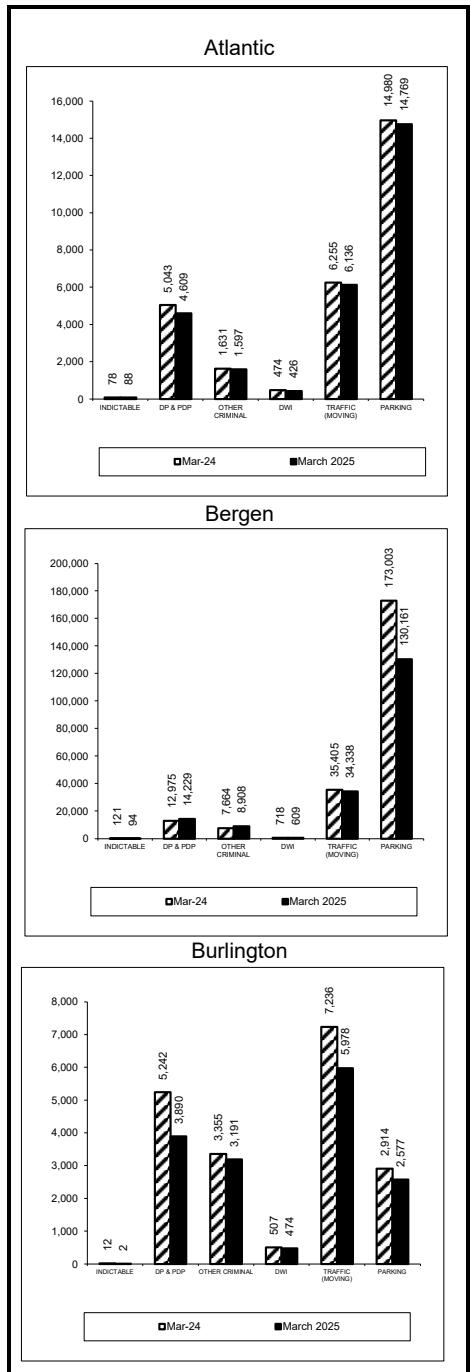

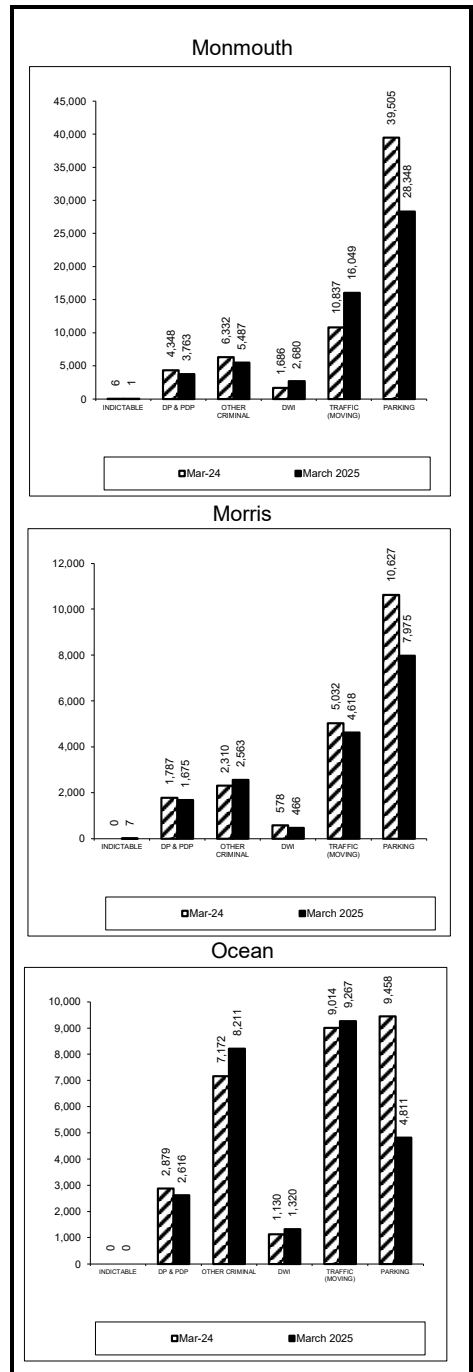

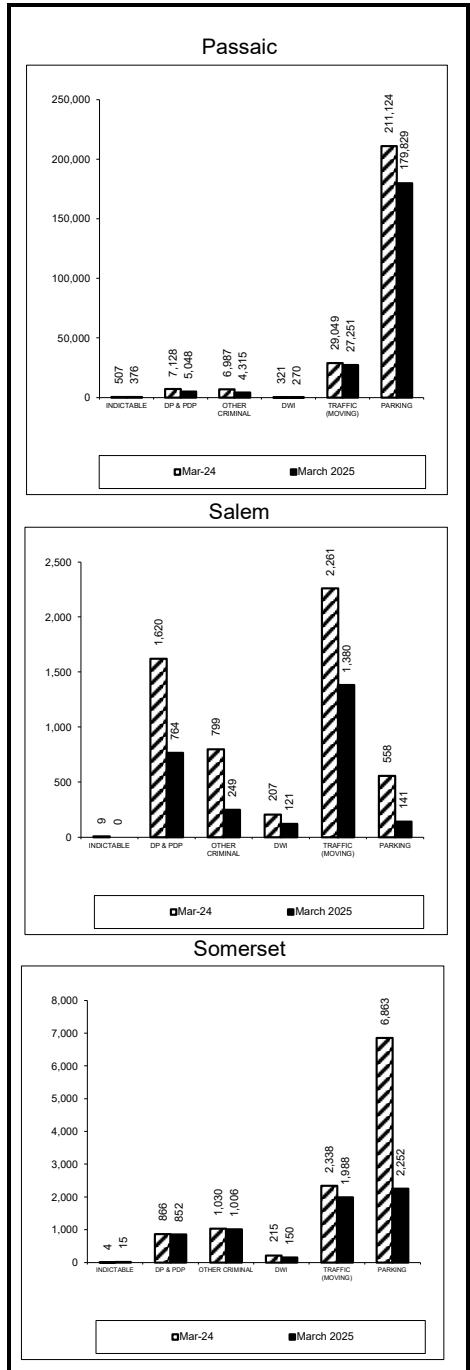

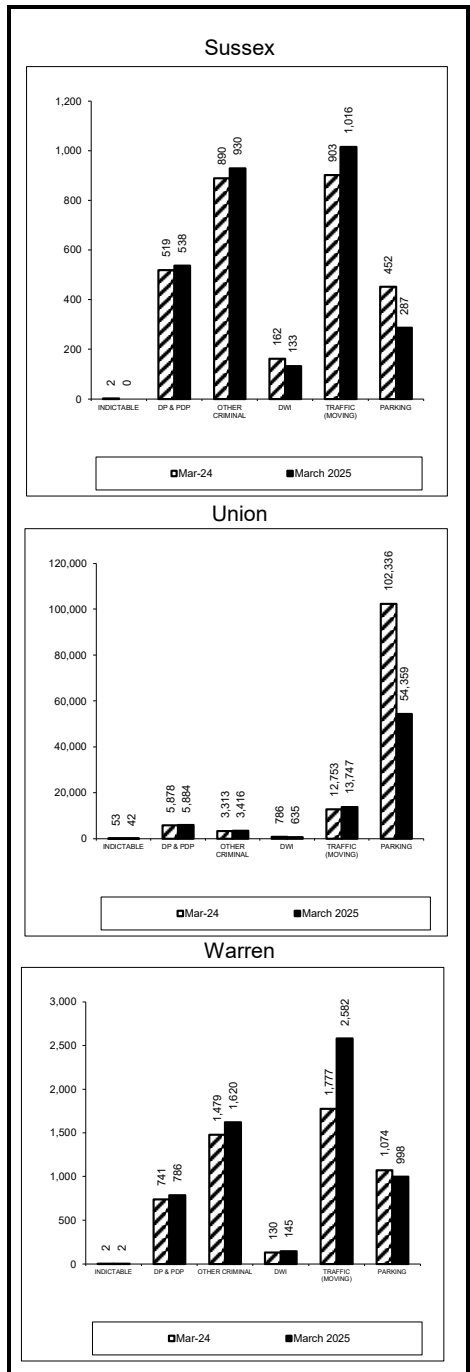

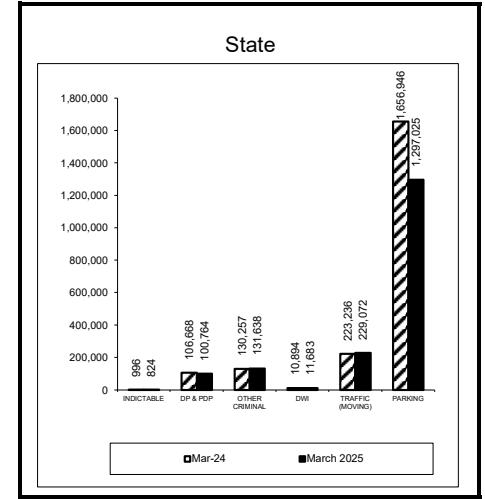

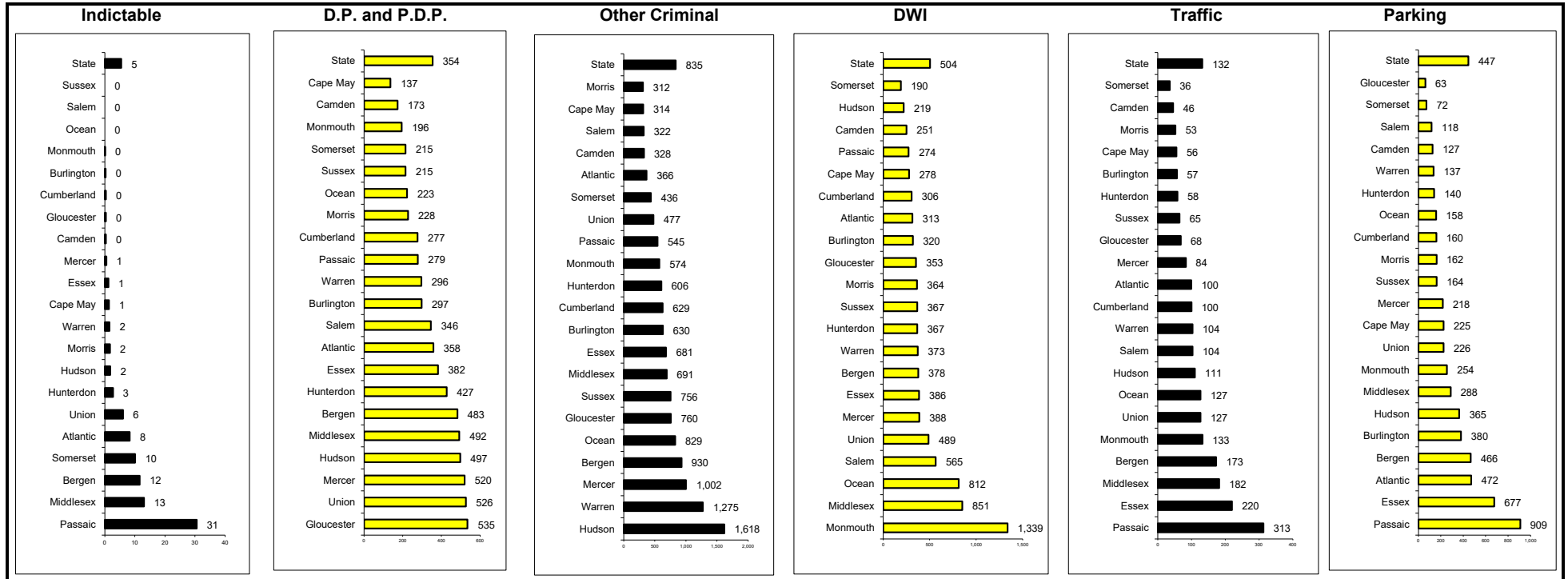
