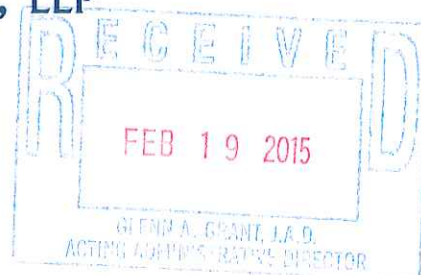

Comments on Committee on Minority Concerns Report

Dear Judge Grant:

Thank you for this opportunity to comment on the Committee on Minority Concerns Report. I am grateful to the AOC and the Committee for continuing and growing interest in LGBTQI Youth issues.


My first comment concerns Recommendation 15.03.2, which urges collection of racial and ethnic data by the Ombudsman Program. I would urge the Committee to consider additional collection of self-identifying data on sexual orientation and gender identity to commence a better understanding of youth within the Court system in the variety of contacts addressed by the report. It is my understanding that the Department of Children and Families has been considering this some time for children within the child welfare system and I believe it is time to commence this data collection.

My next comment is on Recommendation 15.04.1, where I would also urge consideration of self-reporting of gender identity, unless this has been rejected as a possible HIPAA issue.

Finally, on Recommendation 15.04.2, I also urge voluntarily self-identifying data amongst attorneys be expanded to include gender identity.

Again, my thanks for the great work and interest of the AOC on these issues.
