

2016-2018 Report of the Supreme Court Committee

on Special Civil Part Practice

Dear Judge Grant:

The Bergen Vicinage offers this letter in response to the 2016-2018 Report of the Supreme Court Committee on Special Civil Part Practice (hereafter referred to as the Report). Specifically, we are responding to the proposed change to \underline{R} . 6:6-5.

Currently, R. 6:6-5 Judgement After Trial; Costs states:

Upon receipt of the verdict of a jury, or upon determination by a judge sitting without a jury, the clerk shall note the judgment on the jacket and it shall take effect forthwith.

The clerk shall thereupon enter the judgment and tax the costs.

The proposed change set forth in the Report seeks to amend \underline{R} . 6:6-5 to require the proforma entry of taxed costs by the clerk upon entry of judgment by a judge via a trial or otherwise. The proffered rationale in support of this change is to: (1) address inconsistent practices pertaining to the automatic entry of taxed costs; (2) to promote uniformity; and (3) to tax costs not only upon a judge's determination to enter judgment via a trial on the merits, but also in all other instances as well.

In August 2015, the undersigned and division staff met with two members of the Bar to hear comments on this issue, specifically complaints from the Bar regarding the calculations of costs on executions. In addressing this complaint with the Bar, several issues of concern to the Court were discussed including, but not limited to, the following:

(1) the enormous volume of requests made to alter costs;

- (2) requests to alter costs submitted by clerical staff (not an attorney) and without notice to defendant(s);
- (3) requests to alter costs not supported by any documentation submitted by an attorney;
- (4) requests to alter costs being made on Writs of Execution issued several years prior to the current date (in some cases up to 10 years prior);
- (5) the inability of the Automated Court Management System's (ACMS) to maintain a complete record and history of calculations and/or alterations made in post judgment data, including submitting a Magic Ticket, in order to have someone from the AOC, ACMS Methods team assist the vicinage behind the scenes correcting data; and (6) the enormous amount of research required by the clerk's office to investigate alleged errors in cost calculations as well as the level of job knowledge/skill required to conduct

Typical examples that exemplified the foregoing concerns were reviewed at the meeting. Three of the less complicated examples are summarized below, and attached for your review.

Example A: Wage

such research.

This example illustrates a case where the creditor law firm requested five separate writs of execution (from 2/06 to 2/15). Beginning with the third writ request, the creditor law firm comingles miscellaneous costs with taxed costs. Upon the request for the last writ, the creditor law firm realized it's error and requested the clerk's office to correct same by way of letter. In order to verify this information, the clerk's office was required to research and investigate the calculations on all 5 writs dating back 9 years. This process required retrieving both paper files (pre-JEFIS from storage) and electronic files (JEFIS). Hours were spent by supervisory level staff in the clerk's office to manually re-calculate costs to reconcile a difference of \$5.61 due to an error made by the creditor law firm over the course of 9 years.

Example B: Chattel

This example illustrates a case where the creditor law firm requested five separate writs of execution (from 7/07 to 2/14). Beginning with the first writ request, taxed costs of \$9.00 were included. The second writ included the \$9.00 as previous costs plus an additional \$7.00 in taxed costs plus miscellaneous costs of \$4.68 (as indicated by the creditor attorney). Total cumulated costs were \$20.68 (taxed costs plus miscellaneous attorney costs comingled). The third writ included the \$20.68 of previous combined costs plus an additional \$9.00 in taxed costs. Total cumulated combined costs were \$29.68. In July of 2012, the fourth writ included the cumulated cost of \$29.68 plus subsequent costs of \$85.68 (as indicated by the creditor attorney) for total cumulated and combined costs of \$128.36.

In February 2014, the creditor attorney requested a fifth writ that included cumulated costs of \$128.36 plus an additional \$10.00 in taxed costs. A year later, in March 2015, a *staff person* from the creditor attorney firm appears *to direct the clerk's office* to make an adjustment to reduce the cumulated costs on the *fourth writ* from \$128.36 to \$98.68. The staff person from the creditor attorney firm indicates that those costs had been miscalculated such that the \$85.68 actually included the \$29.68 and therefore the

subsequent costs at that time was only \$56.00 (contrary to the submission). Hours were spent by supervisory level staff in the clerk's office to manually re-calculate costs to reconcile the submissions made by the creditor law firm.

Example C: Wage

This recent example illustrates that the creditor law firm requested a wage execution via eCourts in 5/17. The creditor law firm submitted their "draft" wage and it was processed as directed by the law firm.

In April 2018, the creditor attorney by way of correspondence submitted an "amended" certification of amount due in support of execution against earnings" with taxed cost amounts hand written next to crossed out amounts indicating the requested changes to be made on an amended wage execution. Neither the correspondence or the certification are initialed/signed by the attorney. Also, no explanation for same is provided. This is another example of clerical staff from the firm instructing judiciary clerical staff to alter records with little to no oversight.

At the conclusion of the August 2015 meeting, the undersigned was not persuaded by the Bar's suggestion that entry of costs (taxed or otherwise) was merely *pro forma*. Nor were we confident in the ability of the clerk's office to easily and automatically assess costs based on current ACMS programming deficiencies. In addition, concerns were expressed regarding submissions/instructions made directly by/between clerical staff in creditor law firms and clerical staff in the clerk's office to mechanically alter calculations on writs issued years and years prior with little to no oversight. The administrative level work for the clerk's office to provide such oversight and to research miscalculations made by creditor law firms on writs issued years ago was beyond a simple ministerial or clerical task.

In light of the foregoing, the undersigned recommended the Bar coordinate efforts with Automated Trial Court Services Unit (ATCSU) at the Administrative Offices of the Court (AOC) to enhance programing so that costs are, in fact, automatically and accurately accessed by ACMS without need for the clerk's office to evaluate and/or calculate this data.

In addition, we required submission of services for fees and costs consistent with \underline{R} . 4:42 et al. until further notice and such time that the requisite ACMS programming can be accomplished. It is well established that Part V Rules are applicable to the Special Civil Part per \underline{R} . 6-6:1. Moreover, in light of the evidence regarding the difficulties with costs (taxed or otherwise), the undersigned communicated our preference in relying upon an affidavit of services for fees and costs as submitted by a licensed attorney. The undersigned determined that it was appropriate for the clerk's office to have access to this affidavit when inputting data relating to costs, taxed or otherwise, and that same established a maintainable transparent record that ACMS is otherwise unable to provide.

In 2016, the Bergen Vicinage piloted eCourts in the Special Civil Part. eCourts appears to have the ability to address issues relating to writ calculations although currently the

post judgment platform has not been fully developed and eCourts continues to rely upon ACMS programming. Respectfully, the proposed change to <u>R</u>. 6:6-5 will place an unreasonable burden upon Vicinage staff in the short term, and, in the long term will likely be rendered meaningless once eCourts is fully developed. <u>R</u>. 4:42 specifically allows for an affidavit of services for fees and costs and can serve in furtherance of the Court's obligation to parties. In our view, it is unreasonable to place this burden on the clerk's office. The tasks are not "pro forma" or perfunctory.

For the foregoing reasons, it is respectfully suggested that no action be taken on the proposed change to \underline{R} . 6: 6-5. In the alternative, it is respectfully suggested that the proposed change to \underline{R} . 6:6-5 be clarified so that same in no way restricts a determination by the Court to require an affidavit of services for fees and costs, taxed or otherwise, as is done in all other areas of practice.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a response to the 2016-2018 Report of the Supreme Court Committee on Special Civil Part Practice.



Mane and Address of Employer Ordered to Make Deductions:

Unless the designated defendant is currently subject to withholding under another wage execution, the employer is ordered to deduct from earnings which the designated defendant receives and to pay over to the Court Officer named below, the lesser of the following: (a) 10% of the gross meetly pays or (b) 25% of disposable earnings for that meets or (c) the amount, if any, by which the designated defandant's disposable weekly earnings exceed \$217.50 per week, until the total amount due has been deducted or the complete termination of employment. Upon either of these events, an immediate accounting is to be made to the Court Officer. Disposable earnings are defined as that purtion of the earnings remaining after the deduction from gross earnings of any amounts required by law to be withheld. In the event the disposable earnings so defined are 217.50 or less, no amount shall be withheld under this execution. In no event shall more than 10% of gross salary be withhold and only one execution against the mages of the designated defendant shall be satisfied at a time.

The employer shall indediately give t be designated defendant a copy of this order.
