

Brooks, an attorney admitted to practice law in the District of Columbia and the State of California, to participate with other counsel for OneWest in all phases of the trial, and it appearing that Brian P. Brooks is a licensed attorney in good standing in the District of Columbia and the State

of California, and it appearing that Mr. Brooks has a long standing relationship with OneWest; and upon the consent of Edward Daube, Esq., of Greenberg, Daube, Epstein &

IT IS ON THIS 19th day of January, 2011

ORDERED that Brian P. Brooks be and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for OneWest in all phases of trial, subject to the following conditions:

1. Mr. Brooks shall abide by *New Jersey Court Rules* including all disciplinary rules,

2. Mr. Brooks shall, and hereby does, consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against Mr. Brooks that may arise out of his participation in this matter.

3. Mr. Brooks shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4. Mr. Brooks shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.

5. Mr. Brooks cannot be designated trial counsel.


6. No discovery, motion, trial or any proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of inability for Mr. Brooks to be in attendance.

7. Mr. Brooks must, within twenty (20) days, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(c) and R. 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance.

8. *Pro hac vice* admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and annual payments required by R. 1:20-1(c) and R. 1:28-2.

9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this order shall constitute grounds for removal.

10. Counsel for OneWest shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
