ORDERED that Elizabeth L. McKeen be and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for OneWest in all phases of trial, subject to the following conditions:

1. Ms. McKeen shall abide by *New Jersey Court Rules* including all disciplinary

rules, R. 1:20-1 and R 1:28-2.

2. Ms. McKeen shall, and hereby does, consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as her agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against Ms. McKeen that may arise out of her participation in this matter.

3. Ms. McKeen shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting her standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4. Ms. McKeen shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.

5. Ms. McKeen cannot be designated trial counsel.


6. No discovery, motion, trial or any proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of inability for Ms. McKeen to be in attendance.

7. Ms. McKeen must, within twenty (20) days, pay the fees required by R 1:20-1(c) and R 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance.

8. *Pro hac vice* admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and annual payments required by R 1:20-1(c) and R 1:28-2.

9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this order shall constitute grounds for removal.

10. Counsel for OneWest shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
