1. I am an attorney-at-law of the State of New York and a member of Pillsbury Winthrop Shaw Pittman LLP located in its Manhattan offices. I submit this Certification in support of my admission pro hac vice in this matter.
2. As reflected in the certificate attached as Exhibit A, I am a member in good standing of the Bar of the State of New York. I am also admitted to practice before, and a member in good standing of, the United States Supreme Court, United States Courts of Appeals for the Second and Tenth Circuits, and the United States District Courts for the Eastern, Southern and Northern Districts of New York.

Forte, Esq., who is a member of the firm of Saiber LLC, and a member of the Bar of this Court and of the Supreme Court of New Jersey, and with whom I will be jointly representing BNY Mellon in this matter. Mr. Forte, or another attorney in his office who is admitted to the Bar of this Court, will file all papers and enter appearances for BNY Mellon.

Based upon my satisfaction of the requirements of Rule 1:21-2 of the Rules Governing the Courts of the State of New Jersey, and the reasons set forth in this Certification, I respectfully request that this Court grant BNY Mellon's application to admit me pro hac vice for all purposes in this action.


