
THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Graham Curtin, A Professional Association, attorneys for BAC Home Loans Servicing, LP ("Bank of America"), for entry of an Order granting the *pro hac vice* admission of Richard Cullen, Esq., and J. William Boland, Esq., of McGuire Woods LLP and John D. Adams, Esq., and Brian D. Boyle, Esq., of O'Melveny & Myers LLP, with the consent of Edward Dauber, Esq., of Greenberg, Dauber, Epstein & Tucker, and the Court having considered the papers submitted in support thereof, and for good cause having been shown,

IT IS on this 22nd day of March, 2011,

ORDERED that Richard Cullen, Esq., and J. William Boland, Esq., John D. Adams, Esq., and Brian D. Boyle, Esq., are hereby admitted to appear *pro hac vice* in the captioned matter on behalf of Bank of America subject to the terms and conditions that said attorneys:

1. Shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules, including all disciplinary rules, R.1:20-1 and R.1:28-2;
2. Shall make payment, within thirty (30) days, to the Ethics Financial Committee and the Lawyers Fund for Client Protection as required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2;
3. Shall consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against them or their firm that may arise out of their participation in this matter;
4. Shall notify this Court immediately of any matter affecting their standing at the bar of any other Court;
5. Shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for them and for the conduct of the within cause pursuant to R. 1:21-2 of the New Jersey Rules of Court;
6. Richard Cullen, Esq., J. William Boland, Esq., John D. Adams, Esq., and Brian D. Boyle, Esq., cannot be designated as trial counsel;
7. Automatic termination of their *pro hac vice* admission will occur for failure to make the required annual payment to the Ethics Financial Committee and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection;
8. Noncompliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds for removal; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
