Dear Judge Barisonek:

I write on behalf of our clients, Deutsche Bank National Trust Company and Deutsche Bank Trust Company Americas, each acting solely in its capacity as trustee for certain residential mortgage-backed securitization ("RMBS") trusts (the "Trustees") in connection with the above-referenced proceeding. On February 14, 2011, the Trustees responded to Administrative Order 01-2010, as modified on January 31, 2011 and included a Certification of Ronaldo Reyes (the "Certification"). The Certification annexed an Appendix A that identified mortgage loan servicers that serviced loans on behalf of RMBS trusts for which the Trustees served as RMBS trustee and the number of mortgage loans serviced by each of those mortgage loan servicers in New Jersey as reported to the Trustee by mortgage loan servicers in December 2010. The Certification explained that Appendix A did not include information concerning loans serviced for trusts for which the Trustee served as trustee but for which a different entity served as securities administrator (the "Non-SA Trusts"). As explained in the Certification, the Trustees do not receive from mortgage loan servicers loan-level data that would have enabled them to provide responsive information concerning Non-SA Trusts in Appendix A.

On March 16, 2011, Your Honor made a request to my partner, Michael Kraut, that the Trustees attempt to provide to the Court, by servicer, the number of loans serviced on behalf of the Non-SA Trusts. Accordingly, the Trustee identified the Non-SA Trusts and contacted the Master Servicer (or Servicer if the Non-SA Trust did not have a Master Servicer) for each Non-SA Trust, requesting that the Master Servicer/Servicer identify the number of loans that it is servicing in New Jersey on behalf of each Non-SA Trust. In an effort to enable the Trustees to

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provide a response to Your Honor that is timely and consistent across mortgage loan servicers, the Trustee requested that the Master Servicer/Servicer provide current, as opposed to historical, servicing information, which the Trustees believed would be readily available to the Master Servicer/Servicer. The Trustee then rolled up the information by Master Servicer/Servicer and is producing it herewith in Appendix B.

If Your Honor wishes to have the information provided herein in the form of a Certification, please let me know, and the Trustees will comply promptly.
