I am writing this notice to object to your corrected Notice of Intention to Foreclose Docket number F-009564-12. The amount stating from you owed are different from the amounts I was given in notices and letters from America's Servicing Company. Furthermore I have attended Three Workshop One in Secaucus New Jersey and two in Philadelphia PA. My most recent Workshop meeting in Philadelphia on August 16, 2012 I met with Awa-Rose Osobase the new Underwriter assigned to my mortgage case. She is working on a Home Affordable Modification Program to try to put me into so that I would be able to keep and stay in my home.
