We are in receipt of the objection filed by Elizabeth Banks and ask that it be stricken.


The Complaint for Foreclosure against Ms. Banks was filed on January 23, 2009 in her individual foreclosure case (docket number F-004541-09 in Bergen County). Ms. Banks did not appear or defend, and Default was entered against her on April 7, 2009. More than three years later, Ms. Banks uses her objection as an opportunity to make various arguments about the standing of the plaintiff in her uncontested foreclosure case.

Pursuant to the Order to Show Cause filed July 19, 2012 and the Amended Order to Show Cause filed September 17, 2012, Foreclosure Defendants had the right to object in this proceeding to the process by which this Court gave Wells Fargo permission to serve the corrected NOI. If a Foreclosure Defendant objected to any of the contents of the corrected NOI, they were required to file a written objection under the docket number for their individual foreclosure action.

The objection submitted by Ms. Banks does not relate to the Order to Show Cause process. To the extent she seeks to vacate the Default and make the arguments outlined in her letter, Ms. Banks must take the appropriate action in her individual foreclosure action.

We thank the Court for its consideration of this matter.




We are in receipt of the objection filed by Catherine Dimiane, Esq. on behalf of Adel Micheal.






