Instead of the Hermansteins hearing from Wells Fargo as it concerns your modification request, they received this notice regarding the foreclosure.


Although I have a copy of the Home Affordable Modification Plan completed by the Hermansteins, I will not forward same to you at this point in time because I do not believe that is necessary.
