We are in receipt of the objection filed by Fernando Peters and ask that it be stricken.


Default was entered against Mr. Peters in his individual foreclosure case (docket number F-041345-10 in Bergen County) on March 8, 2011. Mr. Peters uses his objection as an opportunity to make various arguments about the standing of the plaintiff in his uncontested foreclosure case. Mr. Peters also disagrees with the identification of the lender in the corrected NOI he received.

Pursuant to the Order to Show Cause filed July 19, 2012 and the Amended Order to Show Cause filed September 17, 2012, Foreclosure Defendants had the right to object in this proceeding to the process by which this Court gave Wells Fargo permission to serve the corrected NOI. If a Foreclosure Defendant objected to any of the contents of the corrected NOI, they were required to file a written objection under the docket number for their individual foreclosure action.

The objection submitted by Mr. Peters does not relate to the Order to Show Cause process. Accordingly, it must be filed in his individual foreclosure action.

We thank the Court for its consideration of this matter.
