
On 6/25/12 I filed a chapter 7 bankruptcy case (see attached documentation).



4. Creating, perfecting or enforcing against property of the Debtor any lien to the extent it secures a claim that arose prior to commencement of the bankruptcy case;
5. Collecting or recovering a claim against the Debtor that arose prior to the commencement of the bankruptcy case and;
6. Setting off any debt owing to the Debtor that arose prior to the commencement of this bankruptcy case against any claim against the Debtor.

Contempt proceedings may result from a violation of the above automatic stay provided by the Bankruptcy Code.
