ORDER ON THE OBJECTION FILED BY LESLIE LORENZANA


THIS OBJECTION having been opened to the Court by Timothy Kane, Esquire, Counsel for Leslie Lorenzana, and on notice to Reed Smith LLP, attorneys for Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. ("Wells Fargo"), and based upon the arguments and all other documents submitted, including the Certification of Cary Brent dated November 19, 2012; and the Court having considered the application:

IT IS ON THIS *19* DAY OF DECEMBER 2012:

1. ORDERED that the Objection filed by Leslie Lorenzana is denied;
2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Lorenzana's foreclosure case bearing Docket Number F-24510-09 will be included in the Final Order, permitting Wells Fargo to cure the previously served Notice of Intent to Foreclose;

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if it has not already done so, no later than December 21, 2012, Wells Fargo will supply Ms. Lorenzana with a "life of the loan" history;
