THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Kristofor T. Henning, Esq. of Morgan, Lewis, & Bockius LLP, attorneys for JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("JPMC"), for an order granting leave to permit Brian A. Herman, Esq. to appear *pro hac vice*, and the Court having considered the papers submitted, and good cause being shown;

IT IS on this 26th day of August 2013,

ORDERED that JPMC's motion is granted, and that Brian A. Herman may appear *pro hac vice* in this matter;

ORDERED that Brian A. Herman shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules including all disciplinary rules;

ORDERED that Brian A. Herman shall consent to the appointment of the Clerk as an agent upon whom service of process may be made of all actions against Morgan, Lewis & Bockius LLP that may arise out of participation in this matter;

ORDERED that Brian A. Herman shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other Court;

ORDERED that Brian A. Herman shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by Kristofor T. Henning, attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for him, the conduct of the case and the admitted attorney herein;

ORDERED that Brian A. Herman must, within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by Rule 1:20-1(b) and Rule 1:28-2;

ORDERED that automatic termination of *pro hac vice* admission will occur for failure to make the required annual payment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection; and

ORDERED that noncompliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds for removal.
