

**SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATION  
ON BEHALF OF TD BANK, N.A. IN  
RESPONSE TO ADMINISTRATIVE  
ORDER NO. 01-2010**

Catherine Morton, of full age, certifies as follows:

1 I am employed by TD Bank, N.A. ("TD Bank") as Vice President and Collections Group Manager. I am authorized to make this certification on behalf of TD Bank and I am fully familiar with the facts set forth herein.

2 On February 10, 2011, I signed a certification of that date entitled "Certification On Behalf of T.D. Bank, N.A. In Response To Administrative Order No. 01-2010" (the "TD Bank Certification"), which was submitted for filing with this Court on or about that date.

3. By his letter dated February 24, 2011 to Brown & Connery, LLP, legal counsel for TD Bank in this matter, the Honorable Walter R. Barisonek, A J S C Ret., in his capacity as court appointed Special Master in this matter, requested that TD Bank provide certain information in addition to the information provided in the TD Bank Certification, specifically, "the number of loans you service for others in New Jersey as well as the names of those


entities” and “the number of loans” TD Bank services for TD Bank USA. This Supplemental Certification is submitted on behalf of TD Bank to provide the additional information requested by the Special Master.

4 As of December 31, 2010, TD Bank was acting as loan servicer for its affiliate, TD Bank USA, for sixty six (66) loans secured by mortgages on residential property in all states. TD Bank is unable to determine the number of such loans that are secured by residential property in the State of New Jersey. However, TD Bank can represent that none of the loans are delinquent or in foreclosure.

5 As of December, 2009, TD Bank was acting as loan servicer for non affiliated entities for 188 loans secured by mortgages on residential property in New Jersey. As of December, 2010, due to a sale of certain loans to Fannie Mae with retained servicing rights, the number of loans secured by mortgages on residential property in New Jersey for which TD Bank was acting as loan servicer had increased to 868, broken down as follows:
