It is ORDERED that the petition for certification is granted;


It is further ORDERED that the following peremptory briefing schedule

If appellant opposes participation by any proposed amicus party, appellant may file an answer in opposition to the amicus motion(s) also on June 22, 2026.
- Respondent may file a brief responding to the merits of any proposed amicus curiae brief by June 22, 2026. If respondent opposes participation by any proposed amicus party, respondent may file an answer in opposition to the amicus motion(s) also on June 22, 2026.
