If appellant opposes participation by any proposed amicus party, appellant may file an answer in opposition to the amicus motion(s) also on July 16, 2026.
- Respondent may file a brief responding to the merits of any

proposed amicus curiae brief by July 16, 2026. If respondent opposes participation by any proposed amicus party, respondent may file an answer in opposition to the amicus motion(s) also on July 16, 2026.
