Appellate Judge Lorraine M. Augostini will give the keynote address. Representatives from the Morris County Bar Association, Morris County Bar Foundation, and the Morris County Board of County Commissioners will recognize the Morris County Mock Trial champions, West Morris Mendham High School.

Law Day is a national event established by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1958 as "a day of national dedication to the principles of government under law." Law Day provides an opportunity to understand how law and the legal process protect liberty, strive to achieve justice, and contribute to freedom in America.
