Staff from the Middlesex Vicinage Office of the Ombudsman and representatives from Legal Services of New Jersey will host a seminar for self-represented litigants who are filing for an expungement application. A brief overview of the Judiciary's eCourts expungement system will be discussed.

Information on the current laws and procedures when filing for an expungement will be provided. The application form will be reviewed and what happens after an expungement has been granted will be explained. Ombudsman office staff will be available to answer questions about the application and court processes.
