The Union Vicinage Ombudsman staff and representatives from Central Jersey Legal Services (CJLS) will present an informational seminar to assist self-represented litigants who are filing for an expungement application. A brief overview of the Judiciary’s eCourts expungement system will be discussed.

Attorneys from CJLS will provide information on the current laws and procedures when filing for an expungement. CJLS will review the application form and discuss what happens after an expungement has been granted. Ombudsman Office staff will be available to answer questions regarding the applications and court processes.
